This play is titled:

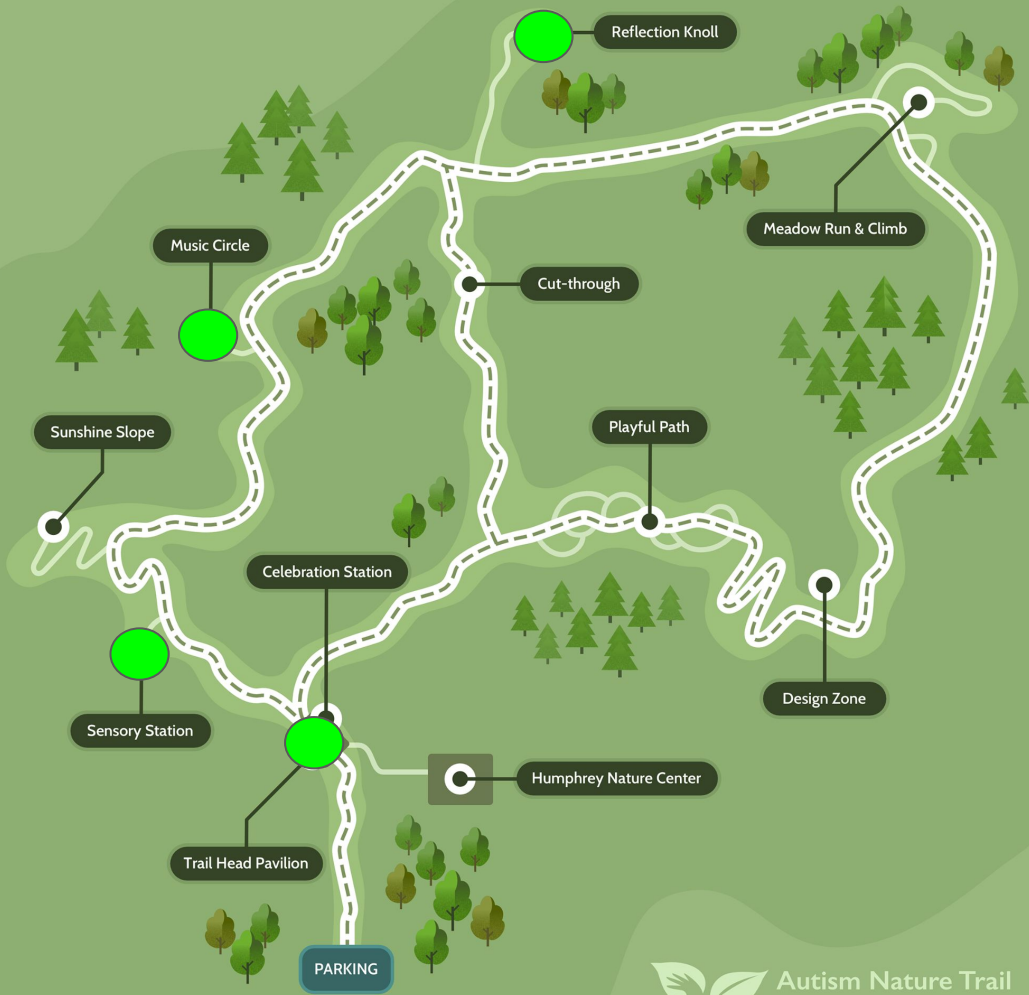
*A Perfect Party for Trees*

We will be stopping at The Sensory Station, The Music Circle and the Reflection Knoll, but we can leave anytime!

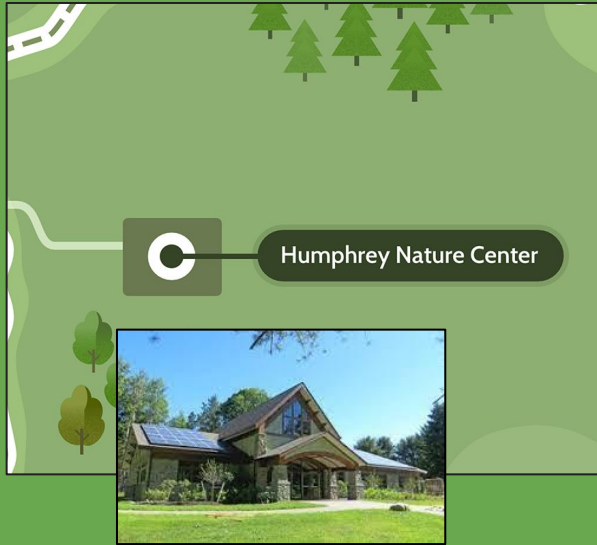




This show will include activities such as walking, singing, dancing and digging!

We will enter the trail at the Trailhead Pavilion.



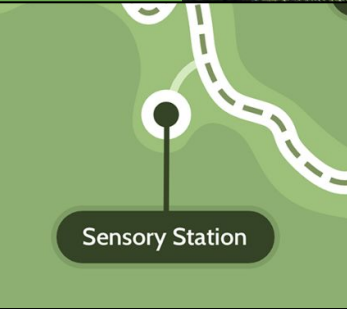
Trail Head Pavilion

show here.



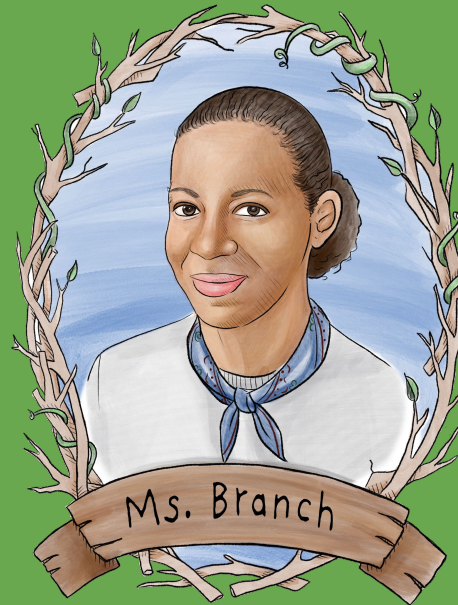
# This is The Beekeeper and The Bear!

Ms. Branch, an avid hiker, will appear to help out!



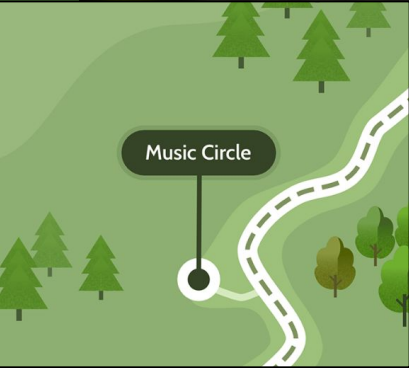
She will guide The Bear, The Beekeeper, and the audience in planning the party.

will meet a bird, Thrush!



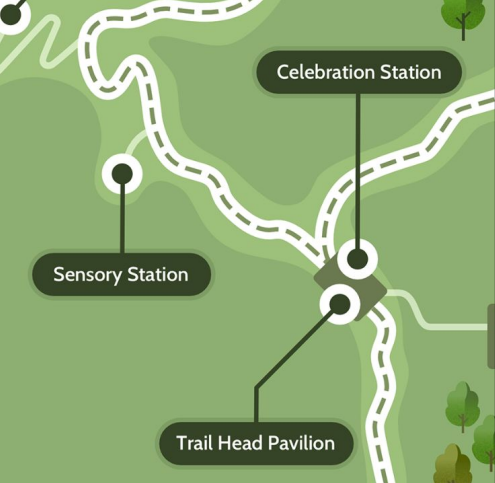
Thrush is a little snobby and **LOVES** to sing!
